Egypt's Vision 2030

A national agenda item began in February 2016, reflecting the country's long-dated strategic plan to attain the principles of sustainable development in all fields, and to determine them with the diverse organs of the Egyptian country. Egypt's Vision 2030 is primarily based on the principles of "complete sustainable development" and "balanced regional development", and Egypt's Vision 2030 reflects three dimensions of reasonable development:

- > the economic size,
- > the social dimension, and
- > the environmental measurement.

Egypt Vision Goals 2030

- First goal: enhance the high quality of life of the Egyptian citizens and enhance his principles of living.
- Second goal: Justice, Social Integration, and Participation.



- ➤ Third goal: competitive and varied economy.
- Fourth goal: Knowledge, Innovation, and Scientific Research.
- > Fifth goal: include and sustainable ecosystem.
- Sixth goal: Governance of state institutions and society.
- Seventh goal: Egyptian Peace and Security.
- Eighth goal: Promoting Egyptian management.

Sinai University Vision

Sinai University performs a role in ensuring an active contribution to the country's efforts to achieve the sustainable development goals of all the United Nations by focusing on goal no. 4 under the name of "good education" and its countering to other goals. To put the university's vision into practice, numerous strategic axes were identified on which the university management and all colleges, institutes, studies, service centers, and other units work in an included and systematic way. Those topics include:

Development convoys and awareness campaigns

At the local degree, the university organizes various improvement and medical convoys aimed at helping low-income patients and providing treatment for free, in addition to organizing health education seminars for women on their own family planning, reproductive health, and literacy services.



At the external stage, doctors from 20 African countries were hosted for a month in Sinai University hospitals to provide them practical, lab, and pathology training, in addition to medical convoys to Sinai University in Africa.



Gender equality and non-discrimination on religious or ethnic grounds

The role of women at Sinai University is essential, with women holding a lot of important positions, college agency and department head of many sections, as well as many administrative positions.



Establishment of the "Unit in Opposition to Violence against Women.

Encouraging innovation (by establishing the Center for Innovation and Creativity)

Establishing the Center for Innovation and Creativity at the University to be chargeable for organizing training courses and workshops for faculty members and the auxiliary frame.



Improved support and interest in business incubators and accelerators as open, flexible, and supportive surroundings for innovators and innovators to encourage and support them to show their ideas and research into startups that contribute to the Egyptian economy and sustainability to higher education establishments.

Transformation of the University of The Urban

The first green transformation unit has been established in Egyptian universities, serving as a model for the university's efforts to achieve sustainable development by rationalizing water consumption and reuse, energy consumption, switching to renewable energy, waste management and recycling, converting buildings into green buildings, and planting surfaces with alternative soil.







As part of providing an appropriate environment within the university, safe passages have been prepared to cross pedestrians on campus with the use of environmentally friendly electrical mobility to reduce pollution and carbon emissions, and accordingly, the carbon footprint has been calculated within the university, and a plan has been developed to measure the proportion of noise and contaminated gases and work to reduce them.





Partnership with civil society institutions, the private sector and government institutions

The expertise of the civil society and industrial corporation, marketplace, and industry has been included, applied with their resources, and worked on joint projects that gain the economy and society.



Deepening and growing cooperation with universities and international businesses to share experiences and open new studies, improvement, innovation, and investment partnerships, as funding of protocols and studies have been concluded serving the industry.

- > Sinai University has been keen to put its strategic plan for sustainable improvement at the extent of the university's three sectors:-
- Collage student sector.



- Environmental development and community service section.
- Graduate sector, scientific studies, and good assurance.

- For Graduation of a college student who used to serve his community within the corridors of the university and was involved in various activities, such as erasing the surrounding society including the Sustainable Development Goals into graduate activities and scientific studies.
